Services were provided to the Consolidated High School District 230 through Gilfillan Callahan Architects (GCA). The school required additional parking so the existing parking area from a loop drive, used for buses, could be eliminated. The following year, GCA was retained to provide enclosed walkways in three locations to aid the passage of students from various areas of the building especially during inclement weather. A significant part of the projects was the application and coordination with MWRD to obtain the stormwater permits.
